

# FaLaLa Sew Along!

Welcome to the FaLaLa Sew Along! This free sew along will run for 6 weeks. In the first week, we will release ALL of the embroidery patterns, so you can work ahead if you'd like. Then, we will make 4 simple blocks (one block per week for weeks 2-5,) and then add the borders in the final week.

Use hashtag **#FaLaLaSewAlong** in social media so we can find your photos. Also, feel free to post your photos in our free Facebook group, *Sew Quilty Friends with Jacquelynne Steves*. We can't wait to see what you make!

The centers of the blocks are 4" finished size, and the pattern will include embroidery patterns for the block centers. There are 2 versions of the block centers- you can choose from the traditional Christmas or Holiday versions (or a mix of both!)

If you don't want to do hand embroidery for the centers, you have 2 options- you can purchase a preprinted fabric panel here in our online shop [jacquelynnesteves-shop.com/products/falala-table-runner-sew-along-fabric-panel](http://jacquelynnesteves-shop.com/products/falala-table-runner-sew-along-fabric-panel) OR you can simply use a novelty or focal fabric for the block centers.

This table runner measures 55 1/2" x 16 1/2". The blocks are 12" finished size.

This is a "mystery" project, meaning that I will not be showing the finished project ahead of time. You only need 4 fabrics for the table runner top- White, Red, Light Green and Dark Green. I suggest using small to medium prints and solids/almost solids. You could use more/different red and green fabrics if you want to make it scrappy, and of course you can add in a different fabric for the block centers if you are not doing the embroidery or purchasing the block center fabric panels.

Here are the fabric requirements\* (they are generous, meaning that if you choose to prewash, or if you make a cutting error or 2, you will probably still have a little leftover):

- White- 3/4 yard (this includes borders, so you need yardage)
- Red- 3/4 yard, *binding is included* in this (4 width of fabric x 2 1/2" wide strips)
- Light Green- 5/8 yard
- Dark Green- 5/8 yard
- Backing fabric- 1 yard (42-44" wide)
- Batting- 58" x 19"

You will also need hand embroidery supplies (hoop, etc.) including floss to match your fabrics (Red, Yellow, Gold, Dark Green, Light Green, Dark Blue, Black/Dark Gray.)

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\*Many people ask about precuts for our sew alongs. This pattern is not suitable for jelly rolls or charm squares. You can use fat quarters or layer cakes. The largest Red piece needed is 5 1/8", largest Light and Dark Green pieces will be 5 5/8".

I think this is such a fun and easy project, you can make these seasonally in different colors like Spring or Fall colors!
